He sent His Holy Spirit to prepare us to be the heavenly bride. How? 1. He reveals the personality of the Groom, His mysteries, His richness, and His power. No creature can acknowledge this Groom or reveal His glory except the Holy Spirit.

2. The Holy Spirit beautifies the bride so that she may become an icon of her Groom. He always renews her nature.

 The Holy Spirit pours the divine love for the Groom within us, that we may be very eager to be with Him. We say, "Come quickly O Lord Jesus Christ."
The Holy Spirit dwells in the heart of the bride, as His own holy temple, accompanies her and guides her to enjoy the fellowship with her Groom, until the time she will see Him face to face.
